Greetings -

The CRSC met on September 20th in Meriden @ 62 Colony Street, 7 areas were in attendance. Minutes from August were read and were approved with necessary corrections even though there were abstentions due to not receiving them in a timely fashion.

Opening Treasurer's balance - \$2626.38

Fund Flow to WSO \$1096.47

Prudent Reserve of \$3,000 in place

Closing Operating Balance \$3644.17

Treasurer's Report approved.

RD's Report Highlights

- Workgroups for the following projects are in place: Traditions Workbook, Planning Our Future, Decision Making at the WSC, Delegates Sharing at WSC 2016 and ongoing are groups allocated to Reaching Out and the NA Way.

Currently they are still receiving input on Traditions 2-6 until the end of Nov. 2014 however they are requesting the fellowship focus on submitting input for Traditions 6-12.

- Four IDT's for this conference cycle include:

Welcoming New Members, Traditions mini Workshop Guides, Group Support and Planning.

- There is still concerns regarding the FIPT and violations through reproduction and distribution of NA literature. NANS is asking the fellowship to support by taking a stand against illicit production and distribution of NA literature.
- WCNA 36 is scheduled for Brazil in June, 2015. MWBR
- WCNA 37 has been confirmed for Orlando, FL in 2018.
- Still seeking Area input, commitment and support with regards to hosting the NEZF in April 2015.
- WPIF submissions are encouraged for World Level Trusted Servant Positions. There will be 9 WB Positions and 2 HRP and 1 Co-Facilitator Positions available @ WSC 2016.
- The World Board is looking at an effective Literature Distribution System. The GNYSO has lowered their prices to be consistent with WSO which may be attractive to Areas on the East Coast.

Currently the Policy for the CT Region

is being updated and is scheduled to be distributed at the next CTRSC meeting. This came up as a byproduct of this Area's Concern about the ability to change policy without the member areas' input. [i.e. disbanding the Regional Literature Committee]. According to current policy an Area's RCM must motion for any decision/discussion to be sent back to Areas. Otherwise Region is empowered to move and vote on motions.

Lastly - hopefully someone mentioned that all Administrative Body Positions @ CTRSC are open to the Fellowship, effective now. The full CTRSC Minutes will be forwarded to secretary.
