

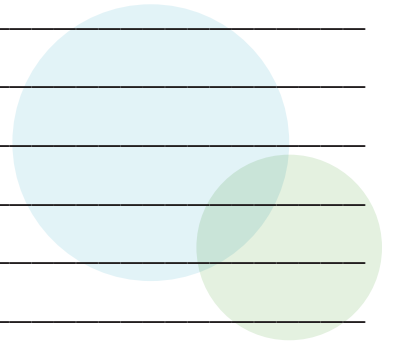
Guiding Principles: Putting Our New Traditions Workbook to Work

Small Group Discussion Questions

Tradition One: Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends on NA unity.
