



H&I Chair Report for November 2016

I attended Regional H&I in New Britain on Wednesday 11-2-2016 and gave the area report. All positions will be up in October. Voting was done and all positions are currently filled at the regional level.

I did attend SFCANA Area this month and gave the H&I report.

The BCC presentations have been on hold since Wednesday, September 28th. After much discussion and many schedule changes the North Wing will be on hold until at least The Beginning of January 2017. The Memorial meeting if it is able to take place will be on Tuesday from 7 until 8 pm. I was contacted by Angel Acosta, the BCC addiction services counselor.
