



RCM Report for May 2016

The regional meeting was held on 5-21-16 in Old Lyme and started at 2.00PM.

Chair Report - The chair stated a claim had been made to our Insurance carrier for an incident in New Haven. An addict slipped and fell and is suing the church. The church's insurance company stated that they should no longer allow NA to use the church. More will be forthcoming next month.

Vice chair is OTF.

Treasurers Report - given and accepted. New schedule purchases will be placed against the appropriate subcommittee budget in August.

Regional Delegate – Adam H gave his report at what transpired at the WSC in California. He did a breakdown of the motions and the voting for each. There was a section on the future of the WSC and one about the FIPT. There is a separate handout for the NEZF and there are copies for all GSR's and trusted servants. Regional Delegate Alternate – Tony F. gave his report on the WSC and the breakout sessions he attended. There was some question about his report that it was not in keeping with the regional policy and contained much speculation, opinion and rumor or innuendo. It was stated that all reports being given deal only in facts (Regional Policy IV.A.4 - All reports given by RSC Trusted Servants deal only in fact. (4/25/87)).

Board of Directors – Gave a verbal report

Convention Committee – Verbal report, stated that the comedy show for this year will be inappropriate for children and will therefore be adult only.

Hospitals & Institutions – There are 6 H&I presentations statewide that have been put on hold because of State Layoffs. This is being addressed with the DOC to determine how best to get these presentation up and running again. Shirts and hoodies were purchased to sell at the Pig roast at a cost of \$1003.50. There is a balance due to the region of about \$36 for last years merchandise. The date for the Regional H&I learning day will be August 21, 2016 and the tentative location is at the Masonicare property in Wallingford.

Web Servant – The area survey online will end 6-18-16 to date there have been 16 responses.

WSR – not present

Public Relations – Absent but left report.

Schedule Chair – Adam H. is filling in and has a distribution list for the past 3 months.

Area Reports were given and 9 of 9 areas were represented. Only significant things are GHA is having a Rockin & Blues activity on 6-24-16. I mentioned the Yankees/Red Sox game and that the SFCANA Activities committee is planning a picnic (Serenity on the Sound).

Adam H. brought up the NEZF survey (see attached) that should go back to the groups and then brought to the Areas. The following month they will be brought to Region in August to be tallied.

Open Sharing – The Mid State Unity RCM was tasked with bringing a motion to reprint the Service Schedules in an abbreviated form. After much discussion it was motioned and there was no second so the motion died on the floor.

There was also some concern about the RDA and if he could serve the Connecticut Region without bringing his own agenda to conferences. The RDA stated that he always voted the regions conscious as instructed. He stated that even if his own personal beliefs differ greatly from those of the region that he is the person best qualified to serve. The RCM from the USA area questioned if it would not be better if we had someone who not only voted out conscious but did not spend the rest of the time speaking out against what he had just voted on. There was no more discussion on this topic.
